Re: Social and Financial Impact Report Letter—2021 Assembly Amendment 2 to Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 to Assembly Bill 68.

Dear Chief Clerks Queensland and Blazel:

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 601.423, the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance (OCI) is submitting a social and financial impact report letter on 2021 Assembly Amendment 2 to Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 to Assembly Bill 68 relating to state finances and appropriations, constituting the executive budget act of 2021.

OCI has determined Assembly Amendment 2 to Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 to the 2021 executive budget act does not require OCI to prepare a social and financial impact report as Assembly Amendment 2 to Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 the following exception:

1. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 601.423 (2) (b) 2., OCI is not required to prepare or submit a social and financial impact report for an amendment if, by the end of the next business day after receiving a copy of the amendment for the Legislative Reference Bureau, the amendment has failed to be adopted by the legislature.

Specifically, on June 29, 2021, Assembly Amendment 2 to Assembly Substitute Amendment 2 to Assembly Bill 68 was tabled by the State Assembly by a vote of 60-38.

For these reasons, my office is not intending to prepare social and financial impact reports as allowed under Wis. Stat. §13.0966 (2) (b).
