Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under this bill, before a city, village, or county, or a town that is authorized to exercise village powers, may take any action on an application for a frac sand mine, the governing body of the city, village, town, or county must publish a class 2 notice at least 30 days before the meeting at which the governing body plans to take action on the application. Under the bill, the governing body must also send, by first class mail, written notice of the meeting, at least 30 days before the meeting, to the owner or occupant of any land that is located within one mile of the proposed mine. Under current law, a class 2 notice requires two legal notice insertions.

The department does not have any local government cost data on legal notifications. A city, village, town, or county acting on an application for a frac sand mine would have a minimal cost increase to the extent the legal requirements vary from other meeting notices required under current law and for mailing costs notifying property owners within a mile of the proposed mine.

The department does not have any administrative costs.
