Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates new, unfunded tasks for state agencies and would therefore increase costs. The size of the increase is impossible to determine, because the entirety of the bill hinges on future technologies and the staff time required to assess, implement, inventory, and report on the technology as required by the bill. The future technologies are, themselves likely to carry costs to procure and maintain. While acquisition and maintenance costs may theoretically be offset by staff reductions, this benefit is wholly speculative at this time. Finally, the legal risks of employing the large language model software, colloquially called "AI," to advise local officials and voters are likely to be significant and must be considered as an additional significant cost.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
