Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill prohibits the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection from regulating the terms of sale or rental of soda water beverage equipment generally or the terms of sale/rental of coin-operated vending machines by soda water beverage wholesalers to retail food establishments. Current law authorizes DATCP to promulgate rules prohibiting methods of competition and trade practices.

DATCP has received twelve complaints in the past five years regarding the soda equipment provisions being modified by the bill. The change would not have a significant impact on staff or funding.

This bill affects a portion of an administrative rule and will likely require rulemaking to repeal the portion impacted by the bill. The rule is Wis. Admin. Code ATCP 102.
