Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates an exemption for a person who has resided in this state for 12 months immediately preceding any semester or session in which they register at an institution and who is in approved deferred action status pursuant to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) program.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

There is not sufficient data regarding the number of people who may be eligible for this exemption and choose to attend the UW to provide an estimate of the fiscal implications.
