Senate Bill 1 is a comprehensive legislative package which was introduced during the special session on Workforce Issues.

The fiscal estimate for the proposed legislation addresses the section specifically pertaining to the WTCS.

## Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The proposed legislation would increase the WTCS general state aid in FY 2023-24 by \$20,500,000 and \$20,500,000 in FY 2024-25, which would be distributed amongst all 16 technical colleges through the system funding formula.
