EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 82

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of the Municipal Judge for the Town of Wabeno in the county of Forest, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the death of Harry Kreienbrink, whose term of office would have expired on May 1, 1983;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 8.50, Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy, be held;

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on September 30, 1981. The circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on July 27, 1981, the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 P.M., August 5, 1981. The special primary shall be held on September 2, 1981.

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Section 8.05(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes on or before August 5, 1981, and the Special Election shall be held on September 30, 1981.

AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
