



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 111

WHEREAS, the Strategic Development Commission established by Executive Order #47 on March 12, 1984, has strongly recommended the establishment of a Strategic Planning Council; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin State Legislature passed Special Session Bill 3 authorizing the establishment of a Strategic Planning Council; and

WHEREAS, strategic planning has been a highly effective means of advancing economic growth in the private sector; and

WHEREAS, an effective, long-term economic planning process can have important benefits for state policymakers; and

WHEREAS, rapid changes in international markets and technology development demand constant attention by both the public and private sectors in Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin is committed to being an effective competitor in the world economy;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ANTHONY S. EARL, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to 1985 Wisconsin Act 84, create the Wisconsin Strategic Planning Council comprising 13 members as described in 1985 Wisconsin Act 84.
