


EXECUTIVE ORDER #124

Relating to a Special Election for the
Seventeenth State Senate District

WHEREAS, State Senator Richard Kreul has resigned as a State Senator for the Seventeenth Senate District effective July 17, 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute § 8.50 order that a special election be held on September 24, 1991 to fill the vacancy in the Seventeenth Senate District as described in Wis. Stats. § 4.009(17) for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1994, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on August 27, 1991. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., July 30, 1991. This section shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
