
Relating to Amending a Special Session
of the Legislature

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN, pursuant to Article IV, Section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin, do amend Executive Orders 220 and 221, and additionally require the consideration of the following legislative business:

To consider a nomination for appointment by the Governor to the Board of Regents requiring confirmation by the Senate.
