EXECUTIVE ORDER #250

**Relating to a Proclamation that the National and State Flags
be Flown at Half-Staff due to the Death of Former
Defense Secretary and Wisconsin
Congressman Les Aspin**


WHEREAS, the Honorable Les Aspin served as congressman for the 1st district of Wisconsin from 1971 until 1993; and

WHEREAS, he served as Secretary of Defense from January 1993, until December 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Les Aspin died on May 21, 1995;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby:


Order that the National and State flags on all State buildings and State grounds be flown at half-staff beginning May 22, 1995 until sundown on May 26, 1995.
