


EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 348

Relating to the Amendment of Executive Order No. 346


WHEREAS, a State of Emergency was declared in Executive Order No. 346 for Sheboygan County in the State of Wisconsin due to damage caused by extremely heavy rainfall on or about August 5, 6 and 7, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee, Rock and Waukesha Counties were also severely impacted by this extremely heavy rainfall;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by § 166.03(1)(b)1, Wis. Stats., do hereby amend Executive Order No. 346 to provide that a State of Emergency exists in Milwaukee, Rock and Waukesha Counties.
