EXECUTIVE ORDER #410

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for United States Soldiers who Recently died in Yemen

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2000, a tragic act of suspected terrorism occurred in Yemen; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this tragedy, 17 Navy sailor men and women are dead or missing and dozens more are injured.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown October 16, 2000.
