### EXECUTIVE ORDER # 102

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Specialist Kyle Hemauer of the Virginia Army National Guard Who Lost His Life During Operation Enduring Freedom**


**WHEREAS**, on May 23, 2005, Specialist Kyle Hemauer, a member of 3rd Battalion, 116th Infantry Regiment, 29th Infantry Division, Virginia Army National Guard, died during service in Afghanistan; and

**WHEREAS**, Specialist Kyle Hemauer provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Specialist Kyle Hemauer; and

**WHEREAS**, Specialist Kyle Hemauer will be laid to rest on Thursday, June 2, 2005;


