EXECUTIVE ORDER # 134

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Private First Class Anthony "Alex" Gaunky of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom


WHEREAS, on November 18, 2005, Private First Class Alex Gaunky, a member of 3rd Special Troops Battalion, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Alex Gaunky provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Private First Class Alex Gaunky; and

WHEREAS, Private First Class Alex Gaunky will be laid to rest on Sunday, November 27, 2005;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **November 27, 2005**, and ending at sunset on that date.
