EXECUTIVE ORDER # 184

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Lance Corporal Andrew Matus of the United States Marine Corps Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2007, Lance Corporal Andrew Matus, a member of Battalion Landing Team 2nd Battalion, 4th Marine Regiment, 15th Marine Expeditionary Unit (Special Operations Capable), 1 Marine Expeditionary Force, United States Marine Corps, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Andrew Matus provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Lance Corporal Andrew Matus; and


WHEREAS, Lance Corporal Andrew Matus will be laid to rest on Saturday, February 3, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on February 3, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
