EXECUTIVE ORDER #207

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Corporal Matthew Zindars of the United States Marines Who Lost His Life During Operation Iraqi Freedom

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2007, Corporal Matthew Zindars, a member of Kilo Battery, Task Force Military Police (TFMP), 1st Battalion, 12th Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, II Marine Expeditionary Force Forward, died as a result of injuries sustained during enemy action in Iraq; and

WHEREAS, Corporal Matthew Zindars provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Corporal Matthew Zindars; and


WHEREAS, Corporal Matthew Zindars will be laid to rest on Friday, August 3, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on August 3, 2007, and ending at sunset on that date.
