EXECUTIVE ORDER # 221

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Sergeant Joshua Brennan of the United States Army Who Lost His Life During Operation Enduring Freedom


WHEREAS, on October 26, 2007, Sergeant Joshua Brennan, a member of the 2nd Battalion, 503rd Airborne Infantry Regiment, 173rd Airborne Brigade Combat Team, United States Army, died as a result of injuries sustained during combat action in Afghanistan; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Joshua Brennan provided faithful and honorable service to the people of the State of Wisconsin and the people of the United States; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Sergeant Joshua Brennan; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Joshua Brennan will be laid to rest on Tuesday, November 6, 2007;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **November 6, 2007**, and ending at sunset on that date.
