2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

It is suggested that all of the subsections in s. HSS 115.04 end in periods. This will eliminate the need to move the word "and" from one subsection to another if subsections are added or deleted in the future. [See s. 1.03 (intro.), Manual.]

4. Adequacy of References to Related Statutes, Rules and Forms

Since the department is proposing to modify certain provisions of ch. HSS 115 in this rule, there are several outdated statutory references in current ch. HSS 115 that the department may wish to correct. The statutory provisions related to newborn screening for congenital and metabolic disorders are now found in s. 253.13, Stats. That section was renumbered from s. 146.02, Stats., in SECTION 316 of 1993 Wisconsin Act 27. Therefore, the following statutory references in current ch. HSS 115 could be modified as part of this rule:

- (1) In current s. HSS 115.01, the reference to s. 146.02 (1), Stats., should be changed to s. 253.13 (1), Stats.
- (2) In current s. HSS 115.04 (intro.), the reference to s. 146.02 (1), Stats., should be changed to s. 253.13 (1), Stats.
- (3) In current s. HSS 115.05 (1), the reference to s. 146.02, Stats., should be changed to s. 253.13 (1), Stats., and the reference to s. 146.02 (4), Stats., should be changed to s. 253.13 (4), Stats.
