2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

In s. RL 10.04 (2) (a), the phrase "to the department" should be inserted after the word "made" for consistency with par. (b) (intro.).

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

- a. In the clause preceding the semicolon in the first paragraph of the department's analysis, the word "to" at the end of the clause should be relocated to follow the word "specify." The clause that follows the semicolon should begin with "and to identify" rather than with "and identifies."
- b. In the second paragraph of the department's analysis, first sentence, "the requirements for" may be deleted. Should reference be made to the part I score in addition to the part II score in the second sentence of the second paragraph?
 - c. As drafted, s. RL 10.04 (2) does not cover applications made on April 1, 1994.
