CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 97–146

Comments

1. Statutory Authority

Section 30.635, Stats., prohibits the operation of motorboats at speeds in excess of slow-no-wake speed on lakes of 50 acres or less in size that have public access. It authorizes the Department of Natural Resources to promulgate rules modifying or waiving this restriction with regard to individual lakes if it determines that the modification or waiver will not impair public safety. This rule waives the slow-no-wake requirement for Tombeau Lake. However, there is no indication in the rule-making order that the required determination regarding public safety has been made. Assuming that the department has made the required determination, it should be reflected in the analysis of the rule-making order.

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

In the analysis, "waiver" is misspelled.
