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### CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 05-029

#### Comments

#### 2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

In s. Phar 7.04 (2) (d) (intro.) and (e) (intro.), the introductory material should conclude with the phrase “all of the following apply.”

#### 5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

a. In s. Phar 7.04 (2) (d) 2., commas should be inserted both before and after the phrase “for a drug.”

b. Section Phar 7.04 (2) (e) 2. should read: “The pharmacist determines the contents are not adulterated.” This phrasing is consistent with the language used in s. Phar 7.04 (2) (d) 4.

c. The last note would be clearer if written to read: “A prescription drug that is returned to a pharmacy that primarily serves patients confined in a state prison is not addressed in this rule. Such a drug may be redispensed to a patient....”

d. It appears that health items returned to a pharmacy under provisions **not** listed in s. Phar 7.04 (3) may be redispensed. If this is the intent of the rule, it would be clearer to make a positive statement to this effect somewhere in s. Phar 7.04.
