### CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 07-018

#### Comments

**[NOTE: All citations to “Manual” in the comments below are to the Administrative Rules Procedures Manual, prepared by the Revisor of Statutes Bureau and the Legislative Council Staff, dated January 2005.]**

#### 2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. The applicability of the terms defined in proposed s. DWD 301.06 (2m) and current s. DWD 301.06 (2) should be stated. For example, the defined terms should be preceded by a phrase such as “In this chapter,” or “In this section.” Also in sub. (2m), “offering a migrant worker employment” should replace “a migrant worker is offered employment.”

b. In s. DWD 301.06 (13) it appears the word “include” should be changed to “includes.” This can be accomplished by substituting “~~include~~ includes” for “include.”

#### 5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

a. It is not clear from the rule what types of “portable smoke detectors” will be required to comply with the rule. Also, it is not clear how these “portable” detectors will be “installed.” [See s. DWD 301.07 (21) (em) 1.]

b. Does the proposed effective date give adequate time for employers to make changes to comply with new requirements?
