#### **2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code**

a. In the related statutes or rules section of the analysis, the statutory and administrative code citations should be “Section 450.11 (4g) (b), Stats., and s. Phar 7.02, Wis. Adm. Code.” [See s. 1.07, Manual.]

b. In the summary of factual data and analytical methodologies, the statutory and administrative code citations should be “s. 450.11 (4g) (b), Stats.” and “Section Phar 7.02, Wis. Adm. Code.” [See s. 1.07, Manual.]

c. 2005 Wisconsin Act 195 discusses the labeling of drugs when a brand name drug product is specified but a generic drug product equivalent is dispensed. The rule appears to relate to that situation, as well as the situation where a brand name drug is dispensed, regardless of whether the brand name drug product was specified in the prescription. The department should expand the plain language analysis of the rule in order to include this additional matter.
