CLEARINGHOUSE RULE 10-140

Comments

2. Form, Style and Placement in Administrative Code

a. In s. PI 6.03 (3) (b) 2. c., the sentence should be rewritten as, “Organization and management of library materials collections”. This comment also applies to subs. (3) (c) 2. c. and (6) (c) 1. c.

b. In s. PI 6.03 (6) (b) 1. (intro.), “under” should not be stricken and “under” should be deleted. Also, “(intro.)” should be inserted in the treatment clause of SECTION 5.

c. In s. PI 6.03 (6) (c) 1., a comma should be inserted after “sub. (3) (c) 2.” to reflect the text of the current rule.

4. Adequacy of References to Related Statutes, Rules and Forms

In s. PI 6.03 (3) (b) 2., in both instances of “this subd.”, “subdivision” should be spelled out. This comment also applies to subd. 3.

5. Clarity, Grammar, Punctuation and Use of Plain Language

In the first sentence of the plain language analysis, should “in counties” be inserted after “county public libraries”? Also, in the last sentence, it does not appear that all of the provisions listed first apply on the effective date. Some changes apply on July 1, 2014.
