#### VI. RESPONSE TO LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

**Comment:** 4.c. In the "Statutes interpreted" provision of the rule analysis, the reference to s. 450.02(3), Stats., could more specifically refer to s. 450.02(3)(c), Stats.

**Response**: The Board rejects implementing this change as the scope of return of health items is broader than hypodermic syringes, needles and other objects intended for injecting drugs.

All of the remaining recommendations suggested in the Clearinghouse Report have been accepted in whole.
