The School Breakfast Program

Analysis by the Department of Public Instruction

Statutory authority: None.

Statute interpreted: None.

The basis and purpose of the proposed rule, including how the proposed rule advances relevant statutory goals or purpose:

1999 Wisconsin Act 9 eliminated the grants awarded under the School Breakfast Program. Since there is no longer any statutory authority to award school breakfast grants, the rules are no longer necessary. Thus, this rule change will eliminate chapter PI 42.

A list of the persons who appeared or registered for or against the proposed rule at a public hearing:

Under s. 227.16(2)(b), Stats., public hearings were not required because this rule change brings an existing rule into conformity with a statute that has been changed.
