2013 Act 288 specifically created an exception to the general employment discrimination statute by prohibiting the board from issuing a license to a peson who has been convicted of a felony. Act 288 also specifically gave the board the authority to revoke a person's real estate license if the person is convicted of a felony that would bar licensure.
