# IV. DETAILED STATEMENT EXPLAINING THE BASIS AND PURPOSE OF THE PROPOSED RULE, INCLUDING HOW THE PROPOSED RULE ADVANCES RELEVANT STATUTORY GOALS OR PURPOSES:

The purpose of the proposed rule is to schedule para-chloroisobutyryl fentanyl as a schedule I controlled substance. On February 1, 2018, a final rule was published in the Federal Register placing para-chloroisobutyryl fentanyl into schedule I of the federal Controlled Substances Act. The Controlled Substances Board took Affirmative Action on March 5, 2018 to similarly treat para-chloroisobutyryl fentanyl under chapter 961, Stats effective on March 12, 2018 and expires upon promulgation of a final rule. It is in the best interest of Wisconsin citizens to schedule drugs which are determined to be controlled substances.
