The proposed rules create ch. Med 25 to implement the sports physician licensure exemption under s. 448.03 (2m), Stats., as created by 2017 Wisconsin Act 341. Specifically, s. Med 25.02 (3) provides the requirements for requesting the extension the Board may grant under s. 448.03 (2m) (c) 1. b., Stats. The remainder of the chapter provides physicians and others with clear and concise guidance concerning the exemption's conditions and limitations.

V. SUMMARY OF PUBLIC COMMENTS AND THE BOARD'S RESPONSES, EXPLANATION OF MODIFICATIONS TO PROPOSED RULES PROMPTED BY PUBLIC COMMENTS:

The Medical Examining Board held a public hearing on January 16, 2019. The Board did not receive any written or verbal comments.

Comment 5.b:

It is the Board's intent to require a request for extension be submitted at least 10 days prior to the expiration of the exemption. As the written agreement between the physician and the sports team will be entered into prior to medical services being provided and the terms of the agreement should dictate whether an extension is needed, physicians should not have difficulty meeting this deadline.

All other Legislative Council recommendations have been incorporated into the proposed rule.
