WSC 2.01 Scholarships. Scholarships provided under section 37.11 (12) and ~~(13)~~, Wis. Stats., shall be available at any time in the first 6 semesters following graduation. Scholarships provided under subsection (13) shall be granted only to students ranking in the upper one-half of their high school class and to a maximum number equal to 15 per cent of the enrollment in the previous year's freshman class of the college.

WSC 2.02 Extension class program. Each Wisconsin state college is authorized to organize, direct, and finance its own extension class program. Extension courses are not to interfere with the instruction of resident students. Extension courses are considered to be any courses offered in addition to the regular schedule of courses offered for campus students during any term or semester.

WSC 2.03 Induction into the armed forces. Any student, other than those provided for in section 40.90, Wis. Stats., who enrolls for two-thirds or more of a term or semester and is then inducted into the armed forces may be granted credit for such term or semester if his work has been satisfactory. If a student is inducted before the completion of two-thirds of any term or semester he may be refunded his fees in full.

WSC 2.04 Displaced persons. Individuals living in Wisconsin who have been brought to the United States under the displaced persons act, shall, for the purpose of determining fee charges, be considered residents of Wisconsin.
