WCD 11.17 Closed area; beaver and otter. It shall be unlawful for any person to trap beaver or otter at any time on the following described area:

(1) BARRON COUNTY. (a) *New Auburn.*

Section 14—S $\frac{1}{2}$.

Section 15—All that part lying south of town road and east and north of U. S. highway 53.

Section 22—All that part lying east and north of U. S. highway 53.

Section 23—Entire section.

Section 26—Entire section except that part lying west and south of U. S. highway 53.

Section 27—All that part lying east and north of U. S. highway 53.

WCD 11.18 Closed area; Horicon national wildlife refuge. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds at any time on the following described area except as provided in section WCD 10.15:

(1) DODGE COUNTY. (a) *Horicon national wildlife refuge.*

Township 12 north, range 15 east, town of Burnett.

All lands known as the Horicon national wildlife refuge lying north of the east-west center line of sections 10, 11, and 12, said lands being situated in sections 1, 2, 10, 11, and 12.

Township 12 north, range 16 east, town of Williamstown.

All lands known as the Horicon national wildlife refuge lying north of the east-west center line of sections 7, 8, 9, and 10, said lands being situated in sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9.

Township 13 north, range 15 east, town of Chester.

All lands known as the Horicon national wildlife refuge lying north of the southern boundary of the town of Chester, said lands being situated in sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 34, 35, and 36.

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Township 13 north, range 16 east, town of LeRoy.

All lands known as the Horicon national wildlife refuge lying north of the southern boundary of town of LeRoy, said lands being situated in sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31, 32, and 33.

(2) FOND DU LAC COUNTY. (a) *Horicon national wildlife refuge.*

Township 14 north, range 15 east, town of Waupun.

All lands known as the Horicon national wildlife refuge lying north of the southern boundary of the town of Waupun, said lands being situated in section 36.

Township 14 north, range 16 east, town of Oakfield.

All lands known as the Horicon national wildlife refuge lying north of the southern boundary of the town of Oakfield, said lands being situated in sections 31 and 32.

WCD 11.20 Closed area; public hunting ground. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue in any manner any species of wild animals or birds at any time on any area so posted with conservation department signs, the same being located within the exterior limits of any public hunting grounds.

WCD 11.21 Closed area; grouse. It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt or pursue with the use of firearms or bow and arrow any species of wild animals or birds during that period of time beginning October 1 and ending November 11:

(1) DOUGLAS COUNTY. (a) *Douglas County grouse area.*

Township 43 north, range 12 west, town of Wascott.

Section 2—All that part lying north of county highway "Y" and west of telephone line right-of-way.

Township 44 north, range 12 west, town of Bordon.

Section 23—Entire section.

Section 26—Entire section.

Section 35—Entire section except that part lying east of telephone line right-of-way.

WCD 11.22 Closed area; Fisher management. It shall be unlawful for any person to trap any species of animals, except beaver and otter in season with wet sets only at any time on the following described area:

(1) FOREST COUNTY. (a) *Pine River furbearer area.*

Township 38 north, range 12 east, town of Hiles.

All that part lying north of Scott lake road.

Township 38 north, range 13 east, town of Argonne.

All that part lying north and west of a line formed by Scott Lake road and East Boundary road.

Township 39 north, range 12 east, town of Hiles.

Entire township except that part lying north and west of Fournier (Franklin-Butternut) road and except that part lying east and north of a line formed by Fournier (Franklin-Butternut) road, the Divide road and the Jones Dam road.
