## 2. ADMINISTRATIVE RULES:

The attention of the Commission was directed to the changes, which were proposed by the Commission on April 20, 1956, in its rules appearing in the Wisconsin Administrative Code, which proposed changes were published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register for May, 1956.

No petition for a public hearing having been received during the statutory 30-day period provided for in Section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, it was moved, seconded, and carried that the following amendments and additions to the Commission's rules be adopted, that the amendments and additions be filed, and that they take effect on the first day of the month following publication as provided in Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes:

ORDER OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES.

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Highway Commission by Sections 40.60(3), 85.40(3)(c) and 85.53(1), Wisconsin Statutes, the State Highway Commission hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

Section Hy 12.01(2). Substitute the words "the size, stroke, and shape of letters and numerals, the width of borders, and the size of signs" for the words "size and stroke of letters."

Section Hy 12.02(2). Add the words "OR SCHOOL CROSSING" to the title and also in the body of the section after the word "SCHOOL."

Section Hy 12.03(1). Change the mounting height from 4 feet to 5 feet and the distance from "not less than 350 nor more than 500 feet" to "not less than 500 feet nor more than 750 feet."

Section Hy 12.03(2)(c). After the word "practical," add the words "or if there is no curb than as close to the edge of the traveled way as practical," replace the words "large trucks, etc." with the word "vehicles," and replace the words "the greatest" with the word "satisfactory."

Section Hy 12.03(2)(d). After the words "erected at" add the words "or within 300 feet in advance of" and after the word "warning" add "in such a location as to provide adequate advance warning of the crosswalk." In the last sentence after the word "curb," add "or, if none, then as close to the edge of the traveled way."

Section Hy 12.03(2)(e). After the word "erected" in the first sentence add "by the authority in charge of the maintenance of the street or highway." In the second sentence substitute the words "the same" for the words "a separate," the words "as is" for the words "or on the post," and after the words "name sign" add "if such a sign is used."

Section By 12.03(3) is a new section to read as follows:

(3) SCHOOL SPEED LIMIT SIGNS. When deemed desirable by the erecting authority a sign of the type described in Section Hy 12.02(2) may be used with a SCHOOL or SCHOOL CROSSING sign, in which case it shall be placed immediately beneath the SCHOOL or SCHOOL CROSSING sign on the same standard or support, but a school speed limit sign shall not be used alone.

Section Hy 12.06 is a new section to read as follows:

Section Hy 12.06 Permissive interim standards for installation of school signs. The standards for the installation of the types of signs described in this chapter are optional after adoption as set forth in Section 227, Wisconsin Statutes, and on and after January 1, 1961, the standards for installation set forth in section Hy 12.03 are the standards prescribed by the Commission pursuant to Section 40.60, Wisconsin Statutes. Until January 1, 1961, installation of these signs in accordance with the regulations of the Commission on school signs adopted on August 10, 1949, or chapter Hy 13 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code adopted by the Commission on November 23, 1955, is approved.

Section Hy 13.01(2). Substitute the words "the size, stroke, and shape of letters and numerals, the width of borders, and the size of signs" for the words "size, stroke and shape of letters."

Section Hy 13.0h(4). In the first sentence of paragraph (a) after the word "on" add "the," and change the numeral "5 1/2" to "5." In paragraph (b) change the numeral "3" to "2 3/4."

Section Hy 30.02(5)(m). Substitute the word "oversize" for "overlength" in the first sentence, and add subsection 3 as follows: "No permit for a single trip for the movement of an overwidth mobile home shall be granted to the owner thereof unless provision has been made for surveillance of such movement by a traffic officer."

The rules and amendments contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following its publication in the Wisconsin administrative register as provided in Section 227.026, Wisconsin Statutes.
