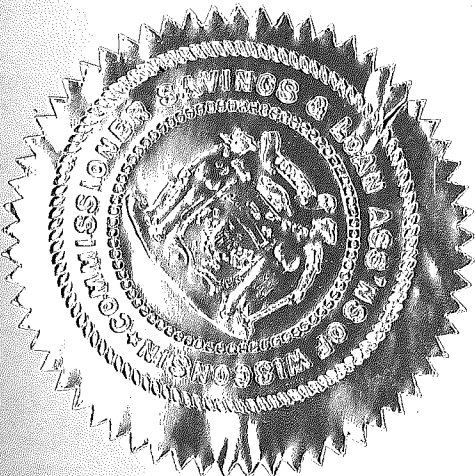



ORDER NO. 35

IN THE MATTER of prescribing rules and regulations, pursuant to authority contained in Section 215.52 (3), Wisconsin Statutes, for conducting the business of savings and loan associations operating under Chapter 215, Wisconsin Statutes.

WHEREAS, Section 215.45 (11)(a), Wisconsin Statutes, requires that savings and loan associations shall not transact business or be open for the purpose of transacting business on such legal holidays as designated by the Commissioner, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Savings and Loan Associations has given consideration to designating legal holidays on which savings and loan associations shall not transact business or be open for the purpose of transacting business, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner finds it necessary to make the designation of legal holidays on which savings and loan associations shall not transact business or be open for the purpose of transacting business in accordance with the requirement contained in section 215.45 (11)(a), Wisconsin Statutes,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

That Chapter S-L 9, "COMMISSIONER'S DESIGNATION OF LEGAL HOLIDAYS" be created to read as:

S-L 9.01 DESIGNATED LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The Commissioner of savings and loan associations, pursuant to section 215.45 (11)(a), Wis. Stats., designates as legal holidays, those set forth in section 256.17, Wis. Stats., except any election day, city, county, state or national, February 12 and October 12 in each year, or the succeeding Monday whenever any such day shall fall on a Sunday.

S-L 9.02 DAYS ON WHICH SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATIONS SHALL REMAIN CLOSED. (1) No savings and loan association shall transact business or be open for the purpose of transacting business on any of the legal holidays designated by the Commissioner in section S-L 9.01.

(2) Nothing herein shall be construed to compel any savings and loan association to be kept open for the transaction of business on a day which according to the provisions of section 256.17, Wis. Stats., is a legal holiday in the community in which the savings and loan association is located.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order No. 35, adopted pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, shall be in effect on the first day of the subsequent month following publication thereof by the Revisor of Statutes.
