as an apprentice shall not be accepted by the board unless the particular shop in which the apprentice is to work and the employing master plumber are equipped and qualified to have an apprentice and that the requirements as to both shop and school training will be complied with.

Master plumbers employing registered apprentices shall report to the board any changes made in relation to the continued employment of such apprentices. Such changes shall be subject to the joint approval of the board and the industrial commission of Wisconsin. Licensed master plumbers in the employ of state agencies are to be considered employing master plumbers for the purposes of this section.
