I, Helen E. Gill, Secretary of the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin and custodian of the official records of said commission, do hereby certify that on April 1, 1959 the Industrial Commission voted to repeal safety orders Ind 8.001 - Ind 8.69 incl. and Ind 8.85 - Ind 8.91 incl. known collectively as the Flammable Liquids Code and to adopt new orders Ind 8.01 to Ind 8.04 incl., Ind 8.10, Ind 8.12 and Ind 8.13, Ind 8.20 to Ind 8.25 incl., Ind 8.30, Ind 8.31 and Ind 8.40, Ind 8.50 to Ind 8.57 incl., Ind 8.61 to Ind 8.67 incl., Ind 8.70 to Ind 8.77 incl., Ind 8.80 to Ind 8.86 incl., Ind 8.90 to Ind 8.92 incl., Ind 8.951, Ind 8.953 to 8.965 incl., Ind 8.971 to 8.985 incl., to be known collectively as the Flammable Liquids Code. The repeal of the old orders and the adoption of the new orders will become effective June 1, 1959.
