


Pursuant to authority vested in PUBLIC EMPLOYES SOCIAL SECURITY FUND by sections 66.99(11) Wis. Stats., the director hereby amends rules as follows:

SSF 1.03 (2) Each quarterly wage report, properly completed, must be received by the public employes social security fund not later than its last working day of the calendar month following the end of the calendar quarter year excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

SSF 1.04 (2) Such quarterly wage report, properly completed, shall be submitted to the public employes social security fund as soon as possible after the last pay checks to be issued during the quarter have been distributed. The absolute deadlines for the receipt of such quarterly wage report by the public employes social security fund shall be its last working day of the calendar month following the end of the calendar quarter year excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1959 as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
