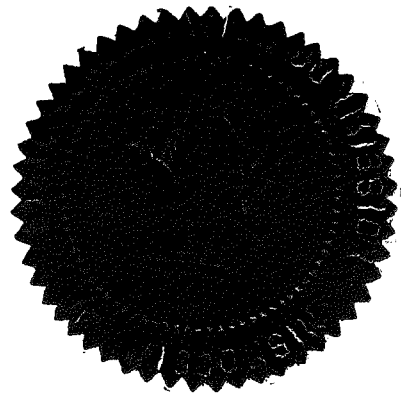

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING, AMENDING OR
 REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085, 29.174 and 23.09, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 25.02 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.02 (2) All waters in Lake Superior within $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of any harbor, pier or breakwater or from the mouth of any stream flowing into Lake Superior except that no net, nets or set hooks shall be used, set, placed or operated within one mile of the shoreline beginning one mile west of the mouth of the Poplar river in Douglas county on the west and ending one mile east of the Iron river in Bayfield county on the east and within one mile of the mouth of the Bad river in Ashland county and the Sioux river in Bayfield county or within $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of the shoreline in that area lying between the reserve waters at the mouths of the Onion and Sioux rivers in Bayfield county.

Section WCD 25.02 (5) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.02 (5) All waters in Lake Michigan within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from any harbor, pier or breakwater in Milwaukee county or within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the shoreline of Milwaukee county, and within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile of any harbor, pier or breakwater in Racine county or within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile from the shore of that portion of Racine lying between Wind Point Light and the south boundary of the J. I. Case-Clausen works.

Section WCD 25.04 (2)(e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

The rules contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1959.
