


Pursuant to authority vested in the Board of Trustees of the Wisconsin Retirement Fund by Section 66.912 (1) (t), Wis. Stats., the Board of Trustees amends the following rules to read:

Ret 2.02 In determining the completion of the qualifying period provided in section 66.901 (4) (d), Wis. Stats., a person shall be considered to have completed 6 months continuous service if such person shall have received compensation for 6 months without interruption of earnings aggregating more than 10 days. In determining the completion of 12 months total service pursuant to such statute, the method set forth in section Ret 2.21 shall be applicable, or the equivalents set forth in section 66.901 (10), Wis. Stats., may be used.

Ret 2.31 When Form 13 (Notice of Termination of Employment) has been filed for any participating employe, such may be cancelled or withdrawn by a participating municipality only after approval by the board of trustees following a determination of the facts involved.
