Section WCD 20.15 (1) (i) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 20.15 (1) (i) Long lake in Florence and Forest counties and Line Flowage, Faye and Halsey lakes in Florence county.

The rules contained herein shall take effect August 1, 1959.
