

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.174 and 23.09, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 15.01 (28) (e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 15.01 (28) (e) Kanow

Township 8 north, range 16 east, town of Ixonia. Section 23 -- $S_{\frac{1}{2}}^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of fractional lots 5 and 6, except 20 a. off the north side of lot 5 containing 23.2 a., more or less. Government lot 7.

Government lot 8 except the following described portion: Beginning at a point on the north line of government lot 8 at its intersection with the waters edge of the Rock River, thence west along the north line of lot 8 to the center of the river road 20 feet more or less, to a point thence southerly along the center line of said road 410 feet more or less, to a point thence east and parallel to the north line of lot 8 220 feet more or less to the water's edge of the Rock River, thence northwesterly along the water's edge of the Rock River to the place of beginning. Also excepting all that part of government lot 8 lying west of the center line of the river road.

All lying in the town of Ixonia, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, containing 101.5 acres, more or less, according to government survey.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on November 1, 1959.
