ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by Section 22.623, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.15 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 20.15 (2) The State Conservation Commission finds, pursuant to Section 29.623, Wis. Stats., that perch are detrimental fish in the following specified waters:

(a) Landing lake, Mill lake, North Twin lake, South Twin lake,High lake and Fishtrap lake in Vilas county.

The rules contained herein shall take effect November 1, 1959.
