ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE REPEALING AND RECREATING A RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1) and (10) and chapter 95, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby repeals and recreates a rule as follows:

Section Ag 10.03 of the Wisconsin administrative code is repealed and recreated to read:

Ag 10.03 Feeder cattle may be imported into the state under an annual permit secured from the department. Such permits shall expire on June 30 and shall designate the premises where the animals will be received. Each lot or load of such animals shall be accompanied by an interstate health certificate or other certificate conforming to federal brucellosis regulations (Title 9, section 78.12 of the Code of Federal Regulations). Permittees shall receive the animals at the designated premises. Unless the animals originate from a herd in a modified certified brucellosis-free area, they shall be tested for brucellosis within 10 days after receipt. Prior to their

shipment for slaughter, no feeder cattle shall be removed from the designated premises except in accordance with the brucellosis test requirements of section 95.49, Wis. Stats.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on March 1, 1960.
