ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1), 97.04, 97.34 and 97.37, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby adopts and amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections Ag 30.10 (2) (c) and (d) of the Wisconsin administrative code are adopted to read:

Ag 30.10 (2) (c) The name and address of each producer who began shipping milk or cream during the preceding month, the identification of the dairy plant which previously purchased his milk or cream, and a copy of his initial farm inspection and bacteriological and sediment test records.

(d) The name and address of each producer who discontinued shipping milk or cream during the preceding month, and a copy of his farm inspection and bacteriological and sediment test records during the preceding 3 months.

SECTION 2. Section Ag 30.12 (5) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended by substituting "1963" for "1962" in the fourth sentence.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on April 1,
1962.
