ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY  
AMENDING RULE PHAR. 1.01

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Board of Pharmacy by Section 151.01, Wis. Stats., the Board hereby amends its rules as follows:

Section Phar. 1.01 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended by adding the following:

(5) No permit for the operation of a pharmacy shall be continued if the requirements for the registration thereof, existing at the time of said registration, are not being complied with at the time of the filing of the application for renewal of the permit.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on October 1, 1962 as provided for in section 227.026.

ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY  
AMENDING RULE PHAR. 1.05

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Board of Pharmacy by Section 151.01, Wis. Stats., the Board hereby amends its rules as follows:

Section Phar. 1.05 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended as follows:

Add to the section after the fifth sentence which reads, "He shall be premitted momentary or brief necessary absence for a meal period during which time he must be immediately available to the pharmacy, and provided no drugs are sold or prescriptions compounded or dispensed during his absence." the following:

A meal period shall be construed as meaning a period at mid-day and/or during the evening hours in which a meal is normally consumed. In no instance shall such period exceed 60 minutes.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on October 1, 1962 as provided for in section 227.026.

ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY  
AMENDING RULE PHAR. 3.06

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Board of Pharmacy by Section 151.01, Wis. Stats., the Board hereby amends its rules as follows:

Section Phar. 3.06 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended as follows:

Delete subsection (3) (a) which reads:

"There shall be filed with the state board of pharmacy at the close of the sophomore (first professional) year of the applicant's enrollment in a school of pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin, a statement of intent to train in a pharmacy."

Renumber subsection (3) (b) as (3) (a).  
Renumber subsection (3) (c) as (3) (b).

Amend subsection (7) (b) 2. to read:

Current full time practice as a registered pharmacist in a licensed pharmacy in the State of Wisconsin in which no less than 6000 prescriptions are filled annually and which is operated in a professional manner and in the library of which there is, in addition to other required texts and materials, a copy of a recent edition of the United States Dispensatory.

Amend subsection (7) (b) 5. to read:


Attendance at a preceptor training conference within the 3 years immediately preceding the date of application for certification as a preceptor.

The amendments contained herein shall take effect on October 1, 1962 as provided for in section 227.026.
