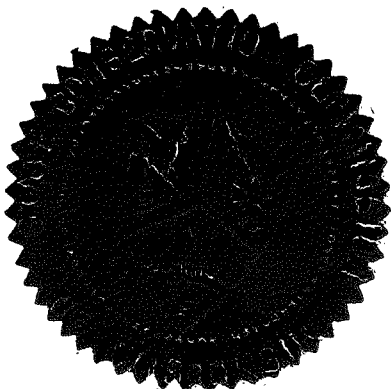

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING,
 AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085, 29.107 and 23.09, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

(a) All that part of the counties of Dodge and Fond du Lac enclosed by a line beginning at the junction of state highway 26, w. 1/2, the east-west or tier line of section 1, 10, 11 and 12 in township 12 north, range 17 east, thence eastward along said tier line and containing surveys along the east-west center of sections 7, 8, 9 and 10 in township 12 north, range 17 east to its junction with county highway 7, thence north and east on said highway 7 to its junction with county highway 1, thence northerly on said highway 1 to its junction with county highway 17, thence northerly on said highway 17 to its junction with county highway 1, thence northerly on said highway 1 to its junction with county highway 2, thence northerly on said highway 2 to its junction with county highway 1, thence westerly on said highway 1 to its junction with highway 46, thence westerly on said highway 46 to its junction with U.S. highway 152, thence south-westerly on said highway 152 to its junction with the C. & N. W. & T.M. railroad thence southerly along said C. & N. W. & T.M. railroad to its junction with state highway 26, thence north on said highway 26 to its junction with the east-west center line of section 1, 10, 11, and 12 in township 12 north, range 17 east which is the point of beginning.

Section WCD 10.01 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is hereby repealed in part;

and WCD 10.15 (4) (a) and (c) 3. a. and 3. b. are hereby amended.

(e) 1. The open season for hunting geese in Dodge and Fond du Lac counties, shall close when the conservation director determines that the harvest of Canada geese in said counties has reached a total of 7,200.

2. The open season for hunting geese in the area described in WCD 10.01 (1)(b) in the counties of Juneau, Monroe, and Wood shall close when the conservation director determines that the harvest of Canada geese has reached 800 in said area.

3. The open season for hunting geese in the areas described in WCD 10.01 (1)(a) and (b) shall close when the conservation director determines that the harvest of Canada geese in said areas has reached a combined total of 8,000, and that to kill additional Canada geese in said areas would be detrimental to and would endanger the breeding stock and future supply of Canada geese.

Section WCD 10.15 (4)(a) and (c) 3. a. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.15 (4)(a) The open season for hunting geese on the Horicon National Wildlife Refuge shall begin on October 1 at 7:00 a.m. Daily shooting hours shall be from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The daily bag limit shall be one goose of any species.

WCD 10.15 (4)(c) 3. a. Reservation requests by mail only on official application forms will be accepted at the Wisconsin Conservation Department, Madison. Such requests must be postmarked no later than September 10. Applications which are postmarked after that date will be rejected.

Section WCD 10.15 (4)(c) 3. b. of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 10.15 (4)(c) 3.b. Each applicant must possess a valid small game hunting license at the time of making application and the number of such license must be entered on the application form. All incomplete, unsigned, and all duplicate or multiple applications will be rejected. It is unlawful for any person to make more than one application for a permit.

Section WCD 10.22 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 10.22 Sandhill Wildlife Demonstration Area, Wood County.

It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, or pursue any species of wild animal or bird at any time, or have in possession or under control any firearm unless the same is unloaded and enclosed within a carrying case or any bow and arrow unless the same is unstrung or enclosed in a carrying case upon that area known as the Sandhill Wildlife Demonstration Area in Wood County, Wisconsin.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect on October 1, 1962.
