
Pursuant to authority vested in the Board of Trustees of the Wisconsin Retirement Fund by Section 66.912 (1) (t), Wis. Stats., the Board of Trustees repeals and re-creates the following rule to read:

Ret 2.41 Major occupation. Whenever a participating employe occupies a single job involving duties which ordinarily are subject to any normal contribution rate of more than 4%, such rate shall be used only if such duties regularly require more than 50% of the working time of such job, in which event that normal contribution rate shall be applicable to the entire job.
