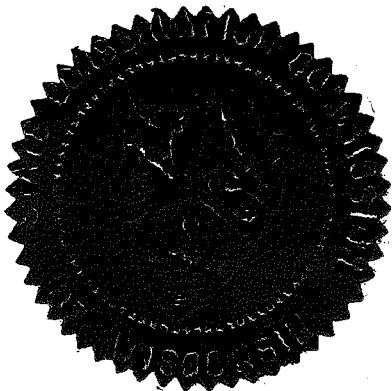

ORDER OF THE STATE COMMISSION AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT
OF AGRICULTURE ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture by section 29.60 (5)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission and the State Department of Agriculture hereby jointly adopt rules as follows:

Chapter WCD 12 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

Chapter WCD 12

POISONS AND EXPLOSIVES

WCD 12.01 Use of poisons, and explosives

(Section 29.60 (5)(a), Wis. Stats.)

WCD 12.01 Use of poisons, and explosives. (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to kill wild animals or birds with the use of any poison bait, or explosives, or poison gas of any kind unless a permit for that purpose has first been obtained from the Conservation Commission, except that insects, rodents not classified as game or fur-bearing animals by s. 29.01 (3)(b) and (d), Wisconsin Statutes, and English sparrows may be destroyed as authorized by s. 29.60 (5)(c), Wisconsin Statutes, by means of poisons, poisoned baits, explosives, dynamite, or poison gas when used in such a manner that game animals or fur-bearing animals or wild birds will not be destroyed thereby. The carcasses of animals and birds destroyed under authority of this section shall be disposed of in such a manner that wildlife and domestic animals will not have access to such carcasses.

(2) Such permits may be issued by the Commission upon application made to it in writing.



The foregoing rules were published in the notice section of the Administrative Register of June, 1962, together with a statement to the effect that the rules contained herein will be adopted without public hearing thereon unless, within 30 days after publication of the notice, it is petitioned for a public hearing on the proposal by 25 persons who will be affected by the rule; a municipality which will be affected by the rule; or an association which is representative of a farm, labor, business or professional group which will be affected by the rule as provided in section 227.02 (1)(e), Wis. Stats.

More than 30 days having elapsed since the date of such publication and no petition having been filed, the foregoing rules are hereby adopted.

The rules herein contained shall take effect on November 1, 1962.
