ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

ADOPTING RULE

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3) and 140.36 (2), Wis. Stats., the State Board of Health hereby adopts a rule relative to terminal sterilization and refrigeration of formula and fluids in the nursery of maternity hospitals as follows:

Subsection H 26.074 (7) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is created to read:

(7) READY-TO-USE FORMULAS. Terminal sterilization and refrigeration shall not be required for ready-to-use infant formulas packaged and sterilized in sealed containers when such formulas are approved by the Board for use in accordance with the methods recommended by the manufacturer.

The rule contained herein shall take effect on June 3, 1963 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats., subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wis. Stats.
