Stats., the State Department of Public Welfare hereby amends Rule PW-PA 10.25 (6) relating to the payment of salaries in excess of the schedule adopted under Rule PW-PA 10. (The rule as amended is attached hereto.)

Rule PW-PA 10.25 (6) as amended herein shall take effect on August 1, 1963 pursuant to the authority granted by s. 227.026 (1) (b), Stats.

(6) At least the minimum for the class shall be paid, but no county shall be procluded from paying in excess of the maximum provided in the salary schedule although no reinbursement shall be made on any amount of salary in excess of the maximum provided in the schedule. Intermediate stops shall be the rate of salary advancement between the minimum and maximum.
